

## WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY

### **Bountium Privacy Policy**

Bountium, Inc (“**Bountium**”, “**we**”, “**us**”, “**our**”) respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through compliance with this Privacy Policy (the “**Policy**” or “**Privacy Policy**”). This Policy describes the types of information Bountium may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the website [bountium.org](http://bountium.org) and its affiliated websites and web-portals including [bountium.org](http://bountium.org), (collectively, the “**Website**”) and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This policy applies to information we collect:

- On the Website.
- In email, text, and other electronic messages between you and this Website.
- Through applications or programs you download from this Website, including Beta

### **Changes to Privacy Policy**

Bountium reserves the right to revise and update any portion of this Privacy Policy at any time. All changes are effective immediately when posted. Bountium will not directly notify you, so you are encouraged to check this page frequently so you are aware of any changes, as they are binding on you. Your continued use of the Website following the posting of revised Privacy Policy means that you accept and agree to the changes.

### **Information Bountium Collects and How**

Bountium collects several types of information from and about the users of our Website, including information by which you may be personally identified, such as

name, postal address, e-mail address, telephone number, any other identifier by which you may be contacted online or offline ("personal information");

We collect this information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us.
- Automatically as you navigate through the site. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP addresses, and information collected through cookies[, web beacons,] [and other tracking technologies].

The information we collect on or through our Website may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on the Website. This includes information provided by **subscribing, downloading, using, or testing** Bountium's services, products,, or information provided by you when you opt to join our mailing list. Bountium may also ask you for information when you report a problem with the Website.
- Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses), if you contact Bountium.
- Details of transactions you carry out through the Website and of the fulfillment of your orders. You may be required to provide financial information before placing an order through the Website.

You also may provide information to be published or displayed (hereinafter, "**posted**") on areas of the Website within our programs, open-source code, or transmitted to other users of the Website or third parties (collectively, "**User Contributions**"). Your User Contributions are posted on and transmitted to others at your own risk. Please be aware that no security measures are perfect or impenetrable. Additionally, Bountium cannot control the actions of other users of the Website with whom you may choose to share your User Contributions. Therefore, Bountium cannot and does not guarantee that your User Contributions will not be viewed by unauthorized persons.

### **Information Collected Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies**

As you navigate through and interact with the Website, Bountium may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.

The information we collect automatically is statistical data and may not include personal information, but we may maintain it or associate it with personal information we collect in other ways or receive from third parties. It helps us to improve the Website and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to:

- Estimate the audience size and usage patterns.
- Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize the Website according to your individual interests.
- Speed up your searches.
- Recognize you when you return to our Website.

The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include:

- Cookies (or browser cookies).
- Web Beacons. Pages of our the Website and our e-mails may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit the Company, for example, to count users who have visited those pages or [opened an email] and for other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain website content and verifying system and server integrity).
- We do not collect personal information automatically, but we may tie this information to personal information about you that we collect from other sources or you provide to us.

## **How Bountium Uses Your Information**

We use information that Bountium collects about you or that you provide to Bountium, including any personal information:

- To present the Website and its contents to you.
- To provide you with information, products, or services that you request from Bountium.
- To fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it.
- To carry out Bountium's obligations and enforce its rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and Bountium, including for billing and collection.
- To notify you about changes to the Website or any products or services Bountium offers or provides through it.
- To allow you to participate in interactive features on the Website.
- In any other way Bountium may describe when you provide the information.
- For any other purpose with your consent.

Bountium may also use your information to contact you about its own and third-parties' goods and services that may be of interest to you. ### **Disclosure of Your Information**

Bountium may disclose aggregated information about its users, and information that does not identify any individual, without restriction. Bountium may also disclose personal information that it collects or you provide as described in this Privacy Policy:

- To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of Bountium's assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by Bountium about the Website users is among the assets transferred.

- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it. For example, if you give us an email address to join our Mailing List, we will use that email address to correspond with you.
- For any other purpose disclosed by Bountium when you provide the information.
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.
- To enforce or apply our Terms of Use [bountium.org/terms.pdf](https://bountium.org/terms.pdf) and other agreements, including for billing and collection purposes.
- If Bountium believes disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Bountium, its customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

### **Choices About How We Use and Disclose Your Information**

Bountium strives to provide you with choices regarding the personal information you provide to us. We have created mechanisms to provide you with the following control over your information:

- Tracking Technologies and Advertising. You can set your browser to refuse all or some browser cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent.
